an old lady

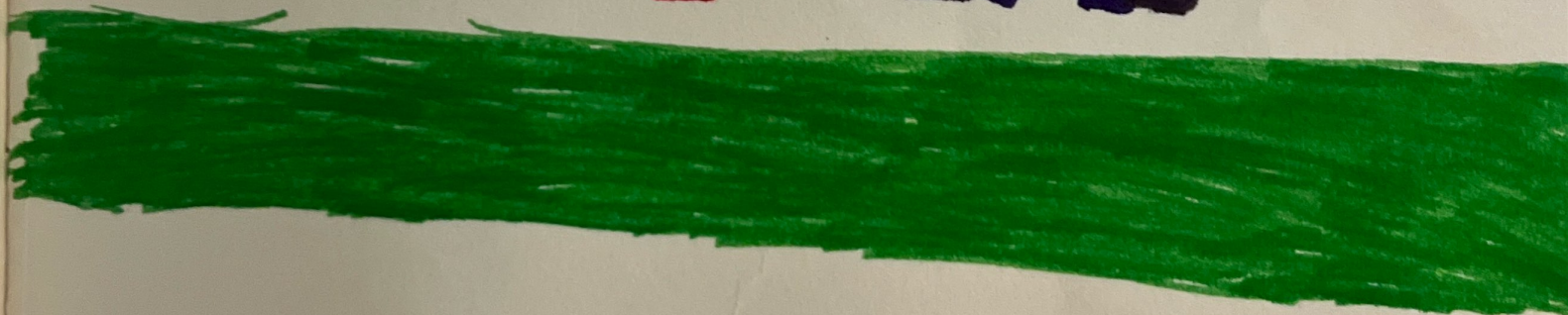
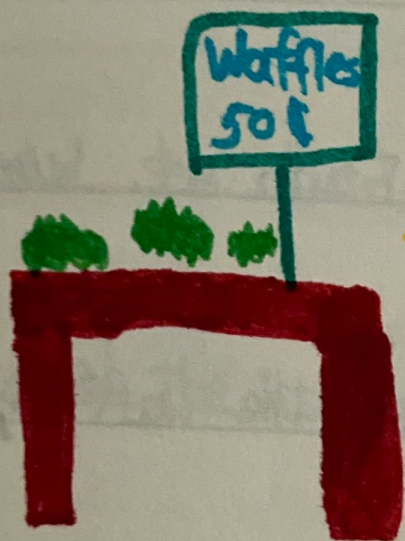
The next day, Peter

the waffles the huntsman

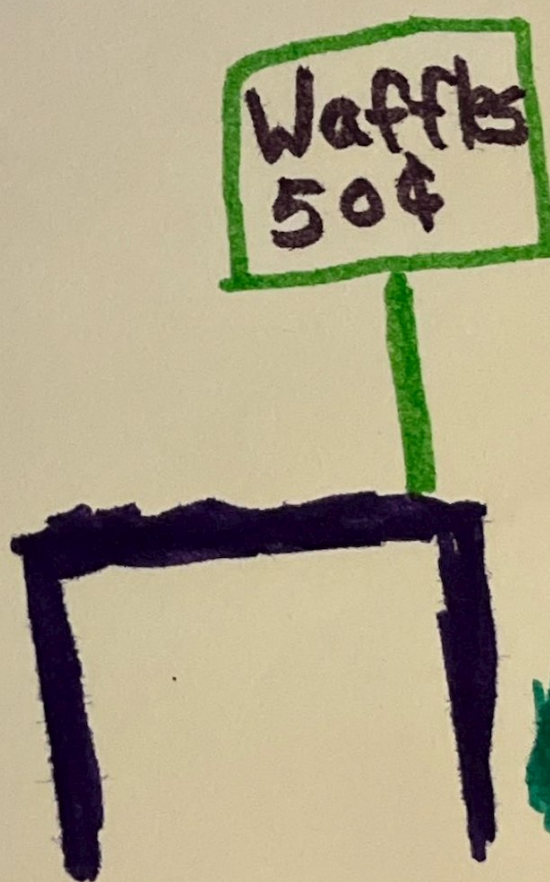
started ^{to} swing his axe.
